Tasks/Responsibilities:

- Keep records of the journeys including mileage
- Submit a monthly expense sheet to the Transport Officer for payment
- Give all passenger payment envelopes to Transport Officer
- Agree to the take up of references and DBS check
- Attend a Safeguarding Adults Alerter training session
- Signpost clients as required to other services via Transport Office
