### Making a difference

Christine first heard about the VASL Community Champions project through Park Run where VASL were doing a local consultation about people's views on tackling loneliness.

Christine asked about becoming a volunteer, had an interview and was accepted as a Community Champions volunteer. As she was working during the day she could not attend new volunteer training but this was delivered in one to one sessions with the Community Champions Team. Christine was also introduced to another volunteer who was able to share her experiences of volunteering.

Christine was then matched with a client Kathleen, aged 92, who shared her love of travel, reading, gardening and the local community. Christine sends the Community Champions team a weekly email summarising each visit:

*"It never ceases to amaze me how quickly time goes when I'm visiting. Sorry I don't stick to one hour but we're never short of anything to chat about and continue to have many laughs throughout."*

Kathleen also gives glowing feedback about her involvement in the Community Champions project. *"I really enjoy Christine's visits. We have so much to talk about the time just flies. I really look forward to catching up with her. I also love the monthly Community Gatherings when I get a chance to talk to project friends and make new pals. Having a Pen Pal is also fun"*.

Kathleen and Christine through their enthusiastic engagement in the Community Champions project have made new local contacts, learnt from each other's life experiences, learnt new skills and enhanced their well-being. They demonstrate that people come to Community Champions as individuals, and become members of a thriving community

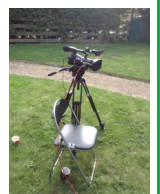
