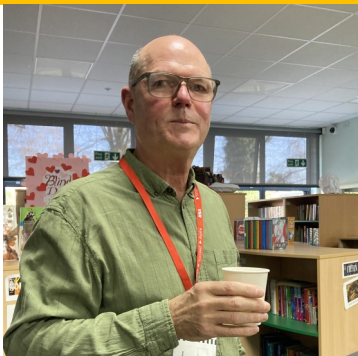

Inter-generational dialogue is an important aspect of the Community Champions project. David, a VASL Transport Driver, agreed to give a 'Human Library' talk to 32 Year 8 students at Robert Smyth Academy about his varied career, climate change and Artificial Intelligence (A.I.). David facilitated some really interesting discussions with the students on; the impact of AI, and whether more can be done to combat climate change by learning to consume less and care more. David and the students agreed with Ghandi's statement that **"there is enough in the world for everyone's need, but not their greed"** and that we all had a role to play in living more sustainably.

NHS App Sessions

Digital volunteers attended Kibworth Medical Centre on 11th March to help local people download the NHS App onto their smart phones. Jenny from the CC team has been working with Social Prescribers at the Practice to develop the sessions and more are planned in other locations. 12 people were helped to use the NHS App at the latest session, bringing our total to 70 people who can now use the App to contact their GP surgery, order repeat prescriptions and access their medical information. Gemma, a Social Prescriber explained:

"The NHS App sessions are wonderful. They are of real value to us at the practice and make a real difference to how our patients access our services. It's lovely to see our patients leaving with smiles on their faces and feeling that little bit more confident with the technology they're using."
